**ITINERARY**

- 8:40 a.m. Bus loads for departure from New Harmony Inn, 504 North Street, New Harmony, IN
- 9:00 a.m. Departure – PLEASE arrive early! We must leave on time. Mix it up whenever you choose a seat, to maximize your time with family members outside your household...
- 10:00 a.m. Arrive Fernwood Cemetery, 920 Madison St., Henderson, KY 42420. Get off bus.  
(private car available for guests, if transport needed to grave site of Heinrich Wilhelm Kleimeier, born at Kleihof in 1841, died at his Henderson home in 1933, by then known as Henry Wilhelm Kleymeyer)
- 10:45 a.m. Depart Fernwood with brief stops at Henderson points of interest, including buildings built in the 1870s and 1880s. Stay on bus.
- Rev. Theodore Gebauer and Lucy Kleymeyer Gebauer home at 137 S. Alves & Powell Streets (highest priority site!) (a gift from Heinrich Wilhelm Kleimeier)
  - Zion UCC Church, 437 1st St. 42420 (Kleymeyer brick)
  - Old Henderson Cotton Mill (1200 block of Washington St.?), Wilkerson's Shoes (approximately 134 N. Main St.), Wolf's Tavern (now closed, but was at 31 N. Green St., corner of 1<sup>st</sup> St.) – all built with Kleymeyer brick in the 1800s
- 11:15 a.m. Depart Henderson for Evansville Country Club, 3810 Stringtown Rd. 47711
- 12:00 noon Old National Bank luncheon at Evansville Country Club, hosted by Dan Kelley. Henry Charles Kleymeyer was on the Board, 1930s). Our only bathroom break. *Please* re-board bus *early*.
- 1:15 p.m. Depart ECC for Oak Hill Cemetery, 1400 E. Virginia St., 47711
- 1:30 p.m. Arrive Oak Hill Cemetery for memorial ceremony for Martha Ruth Kleymeyer. Get off bus. Private car available if transport needed to grave site.
- 2:15 p.m. Depart Oak Hill Cemetery for windshield tour of Evansville points of interest:
- Henry Charles Kleymeyer home, 608 E. Powell
  - Bosse High School, 1300 Washington Ave. (approx. a dozen Kleymeyers attended)
  - Various Kleymeyer homes: 812 S. Alvord Blvd.; 2300 E. Chandler Ave.; and 601 S. Boeke Rd.
  - Univ. of Evansville, 1800 Lincoln Ave. (several K's attended; two on the Board)
  - Bosse Field, 2301 N. First Ave. (where "A League of Their Own" was filmed; built with Kleymeyer brick)
- 3:15 p.m. Arrive at Kleymeyer Park, 2301 N. First Ave. Get off bus for group photo. Smiiiiiiiile!
- 3:45 p.m. Depart Kleymeyer Park for New Harmony
- 4:30 p.m. Arrive at New Harmony Inn; hopefully in time to visit Historic New Harmony
